❖ **On leaving the hotel:**

Turn off lights and air conditioning in order to save energy and avoid overloading the city's electrical systems.

❖ **Protect natural parks and historic areas:**

These areas are national assets and in the case of Cartagena, a world heritage site. Be a friendly and informed visitor, know the flora and fauna that is being protected there, do not throw garbage that impoverish the image of the place and take care of the quiet environment of these areas.



❖ **Know the local culture:**

Connect with the community you visit, a tourist shares with local experiences and impressions about your visit. Above all, be respectful of the customs, traditions and places of the community you visit.

❖ **Support small, medium and micro enterprises:**

Tourism is the main economic activity of many places, many families find their livelihood in this activity, if you have the opportunity to support some of the products or services offered by companies in the city, do so.

❖ **Say No to Sexual Exploitation:**

This scourge must also involve the visitor in the prevention and protection of victims.

❖ **Reduce your CO₂ emissions:**

If you travel by car or bus, turn it off while you are standing still. Avoid using clothes irons and irons and hair dryers

❖ **Help conserve the natural environment:** Protect the flora and fauna and their habitat, and do not buy products made from plants or animals on the way to extinction.



Before leaving on a trip, inquire about the actual health status of your destination and about your access to consular and emergency services, and make sure that your health and personal safety will not be compromised. Make sure you have covered there your specific needs (food, accessibility or medical care) before deciding to travel to a certain destination.

Gather all possible information about your destination, and take time to understand their customs, rules and traditions. Avoid behaviors that may offend the local population.

Inquire about the current legislation so as not to commit any act that is considered criminal in the place visited. Do not deal with drugs, weapons, antiques, protected species, or dangerous products or substances or prohibited by regulations
